# 2010 Walter Miller Memorial Scholarship Tournament

## Rules and Format

- 1. ELIGIBILITY:** The tournament is open to all Colorado USBC Youth certified bowlers.
- 2. DIVISIONS:** Handicap 12 years of age and younger; Handicap 13 years of age and older; Classified Scratch (185 average and under); Open Scratch.
- 3. PARTICIPATION:** Multiple participation is allowed. Bowlers may place only once with their highest scores. Bowlers may only bowl in one division.
- 4. ENTRY FEES:** Handicap division — \$20.00 (\$5.00 lineage, \$2.00 expenses, \$13.00 awards); Scratch divisions — \$25.00 (\$10.00 lineage, \$2.00 expenses, \$13.00 awards).
- 5. FORMAT:** Handicap divisions – Bowl three games on one pair of lanes. Scratch divisions – Bowl six games across 12 lanes.
- 6. AVERAGES:** Bowlers will use their highest average of 12 games or more as of December 1, 2009. If bowler does not have a 12 game average by December 1, 2009, then submit a current league standing sheet (with 12 games or more) at time of check-in. If bowler has no current average, then use highest verifiable 2009 Summer league average of at least 9 games. If none, then use highest 2008-2009 book average. Handicap and Classified Scratch divisions must provide average verification, with entry, to the tournament director. Bowlers who do not provide proper average verification will be allowed to bowl, but will not receive any handicap, or may bowl the Open Scratch division.
- 7. HANDICAP:** Handicap will be 90% of 200.
- 8. DRESS CODE:** Appropriate attire must be worn. Boys must wear slacks and a collared shirt. Girls may wear slacks, skirts or skorts and a collared shirt. Skirts and skorts must be no shorter than six inches above the knee. Jeans are discouraged, but will be allowed (if in good condition and subject solely to the tournament director's approval). Absolutely no shorts, t-shirts or hats are allowed. Dress code will be strictly enforced at the tournament director's discretion. Bowlers not in compliance may bowl, but must pay a \$10.00 fine (to be added to the award fund).
- 9. ENTRY CLOSING DATE:** Reserved entries close March 1, 2010. Re-entries and walk-ins will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to each squad if lanes are available. Confirmation of entries is automatic. You will receive your first choice unless otherwise notified.
- 10. CHECK-IN:** Check-in will begin one hour prior to each squad.
- 11. AWARDS:** Scholarships will be awarded at a ratio of 1 for every 10 entries. All award fees will be returned 100%. Scholarships will be administered by the USBC SMART Program.
- 12. TOURNAMENT RULES:** Any rules not covered herein will be governed by USBC Youth tournament rules. Decisions of tournament management will be final.
- 13. EARLY TERMINATION OF TOURNAMENT:** Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency, natural disaster or any other reason beyond the control of the CSBPA and its directors shall cause, to the extent required, all prizes (guaranteed or otherwise) to be pro-rated according to the number of entries at the time of such termination.

## about walter miller



Walter Miller was born in Mattoon, Illinois, on May 4, 1908. He graduated from High School in 1927 after a successful athletic career. In 1934 he married Margaret Kingsbury and moved to Colorado in 1941.

His bowling career began in Iowa in 1929. He was one of Iowa's and Colorado's top bowlers for many years.

Walter became a bowling proprietor in 1947 and later acquired Athmar Bowl where he served as co-owner and General Manager until 1978.

Shortly thereafter, he became the Executive Director of the Colorado State Bowling Proprietor's Association, an office he held until 1989.

Walter was elected to the Denver Bowling Hall of Fame in 1979 and later the Colorado Bowling Hall of Fame in 1995. He was also honored with the Denver Bowling Association's Distinguished Service Award and the Golden Ten Pin Award.

Walter's true passion and perhaps greatest contribution to the sport was his dedication toward the betterment of youth bowling which is why this event is named in his honor.
